





#### Q4 How would you rate the quality of water from West End Water Supply?



#### Q5 How would you rate the water pressure from West End Water Supply?




# Q6 What is the maximum amount of RTTX Tax Dollars would you approve investing in upgrading the fresh water system owned by West End Water Supply?







# Q7 For the last two years, the Town has used approximately \$100,000 per year of Tax Dollars to support the wastewater system. How should the Town cover these costs?





# Q8 Would you be in favor of spending Tax Dollars to lease/improve/maintain a designated area for public parking?





## Q9 Are you in favor of spending \$250,000 as RTTX part of the TXDOT project for walking paths along Hwy 237 and Live Oak Street?





# Q10 As part of the TXDOT Project would you be in favor of a pedestrian crossing with a pedestrian controlled traffic signal on Hwy 237?














#### Q17 What is your opinion of the current zoning ordinance?


#### Q18 How often should the zoning ordinance be amended?


#### Q19 What should the makeup of the Planning & Zoning Commission be?










### Q25 In general, how do you feel about annexation, given that there might be some difficult legislation to overcome?


